Whether you are going for adventure or for business, to explore new cultures, to serve others, or to visit friends and relatives, international travel can enrich your life. Let us help you prepare to have a healthy and enjoyable journey.



The Mono County Travel Clinic provides the following services:

- A full range of travel immunizations at reasonable prices, including yellow fever vaccine and certification.
- Individualized and up-to-date information on travel related health and safety concerns.
- Anti-malaria medication counseling and prescriptions.
- Information on food and water precautions including the prevention and treatment of traveler's diarrhea.

A Public Health Nurse will review your travel plans with you and discuss potential risks as well as determine the immunizations you may need . Consultation with the Health Officer available as needed.

Contact us in advance, 4-6 weeks is often needed to develop an optimal antibody response and protection.

Please bring the following to your appointment;

- * Immunization records if available
- * Travel itinerary
- * Information regarding your medical status and current medications
