Welcome Baby! & Healthy Families

- A free, personalized home visiting program for all Mono County babies, prenatal through preschool, TK, or Kindergarten entry.
- This program provides a network of support, breastfeeding education, developmental screenings, a Kit for New Parents, and ideas you can use during the first days and months and years of your child's life. Each visit seeks to support parents as their child's first and most important teachers and covers three areas specific to each family and child: a parent child activity, developmental parenting, and family well-being. The program is an evidence-based Parents as Teachers program and handouts are Parents as Teachers as well.

Mono County WIC Program

- WIC participants (low-medium income eligible) throughout Mono County may receive breastfeeding support and education from a Certified Lactation Counselor, and/or a hospital-grade electric breast pump loaned at no cost.
