**Reasons why project is exempt:** This project would create a Conservation Easement for the purposes of clarifying and formally establishing future management practices on the Conway and Mattly Ranch, in order to ensure that conservation values of the property will be maintained in perpetuity. The action is covered in several exemption classes described below:

Class 7 consists of actions taken by regulatory agencies as authorized by state law or local ordinance to assure the maintenance, restoration, or enhancement of a natural resource where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the environment.

Class 8 consists of actions taken by regulatory agencies, as authorized by state or local ordinance, to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of the environment where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the environment.

Class 17 consists of the establishment of agricultural preserves, the making and renewing of open space contracts under the Williamson Act, or the acceptance of easements or fee interests in order to maintain the open space character of the area.

Additionally, CEQA Section 15004(b)(2)(A) relating to the Time of Preparation for CEQA documents applies here, as preferred sites for development have been identified and future use has been conditioned on CEQA compliance.
