Fiscal Technical Specialist I

Working under close supervision this is an entry level position. Employees in this class receive in-service training and are given detailed instructions in the performance of routine accounting, statistical and case recordkeeping tasks. Employees are expected to promote to the Fiscal Technical Specialist II level after one year of satisfactory performance.

Fiscal Technical Specialist II

Working under general supervision this is a journey level position. Employees at this level are expected to have background and experience in the area of financial, statistical, or case recordkeeping and reporting.

Example Skills and Duties:

- Maintains financial and statistical records.
- Prepares or assists in preparing statistical and fiscal reports.
- Assists with compilation of budget information including work and time records.
- Codes, verifies, and files various financial documents.
- Handles money transactions.
- Checks, balances, and reconciles cash statements and computerized reports.
- Processes or assists with the processing of documents such as invoices, purchase orders, warrants, and other records.
- Writes letters, memos, or documents to correspond with public and private organizations/agencies to obtain or verify information.
- Answers telephone calls to provide, elicit, or verify information or data.
- Performs other clerical duties such as typing, filing, counter service, copying, etc. on an as needed basis.
- Performs related duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Six months to one year of full-time clerical experience. Or equivalent to 15-30 semester units or 22.5-45 quarter units that included relevant coursework.

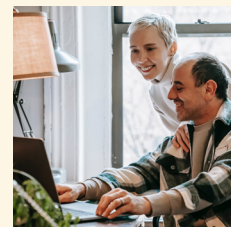

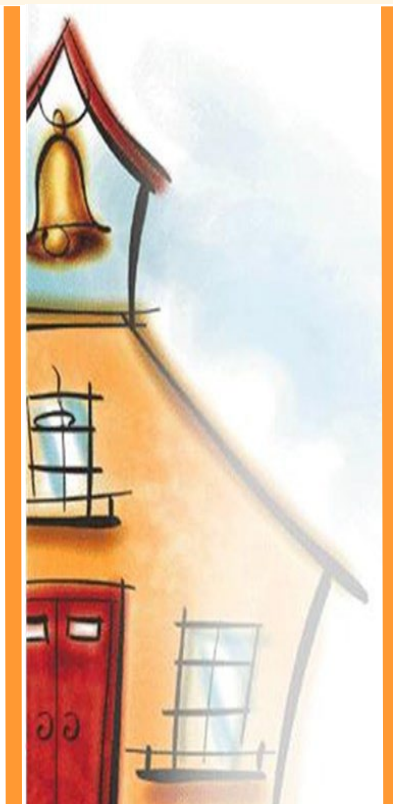

The federally funded **Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)** offers up to \$30 a month off High-Speed Home Internet for qualifying households. Now everyone can get online at the same time for less. Those with Lifeline mobile benefits can also get ACP.

If you are struggling with household expenses, the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) can help with the high cost of home internet. **The program offers eligible households up to a \$30 discount on their monthly internet bill (\$75 for households on qualifying Tribal lands).** ACP households are also eligible for a one-time \$100 discount when buying a laptop or tablet from participating providers.

To qualify for ACP, at least one household member must be enrolled in one of the following government assistance programs: Lifeline, Free or Reduced School Lunch Program (NSLP), CalFresh, Medi-Cal or Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Pell Grant or WIC (Women, Infants & Children), Veteran's pension, and Federal Public Housing Assistance. Households may also qualify if they have a household income of \$55,500 or less for a family of 4 (add \$9,000 per additional family member).
